Internship Programme

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR THE APPLICANT

OPPORTUNITY - This programme offers the opportunity to gain valuable work and ministry experience with a growing church, deeply involved in community and outreach. You will be working closely with the elders and the pastoral team, having the opportunity to serve and exercise your gifts.

If you are considering a gap year or a year out and your aged between 18-25, we would like you to consider prayerfully becoming part of the team here. We're excited about what God has for you!

PURPOSE - The internship programme is designed to build up future leaders and potential workers in ministry covering a wide range of activities from children and youth to church planting. This does not guarantee future employment but enables the successful applicants to gain experience and add strength to the ministry team already in place. The programme will include practical skill development and leadership capabilities, with an amount of freedom for creativity and initiative.

DURATION - This is an ONE YEAR internship programme, beginning on 1st September and ending on 31st August the following year. There are a total 20 working days set for holidays, outside of normal days off. Applicants who prefer a shorter internship may be accommodated, pending approval from the church leadership.

FINANCES - The church is committed to provide pocket money of £40 per week (paid monthly). At this point in time, this is not a paid internship.

DESCRIPTION - Each ministry has its own specific description but in general we expect the successful applicant to be able to work in a team with the volunteers who are already involved in the ministry. Leadership responsibilities will be given according the each applicant's ability. The interns will be directly accountable to the Elders of the church. The interns are expected to attend staff meetings and devotional and prayer times with the pastor and other members of staff. The Elders will provide mentoring, guidance and support as well as the bi-monthly appraisals.

APPRAISAL - This will take place every 2 months and will be led by one of the Elders looking at all aspects of the ministry with the purpose to encourage and correct if necessary. The intern's prayer life, team work, leadership skills and ministry tasks will all be considered.

You will be expected to work full-time at the church, (schedule varying with evening and Sunday ministries) and you will receive a weekly bursary.

As an intern you would be expected to be a regular attendee at our main church services and also be part of our prayer times. This internship will involve working with young people and adults at risk of harm and therefore you must apply for an ACCESS NI check and become familiar with our Safeguarding Policy for Children and Adults at risk.

Weekly Schedule:

The Intern's week is split between main church tasks and other activities. Those other activities will also come into your daily routine, such as maintaining and cleaning church property, planning meetings for events, etc. However, we want to make the internship about you and fashion it in a way that will best develop you. Therefore, you may not do all of these tasks or you may be asked to do something else outside of these.
